Turner Prize 2019

One of the best known prizes for visual arts in the world, Turner Prize 2019 is coming to Turner Contemporary. Every other year, the prize leaves Tate Britain and is presented at a venue outside London. Four of the most exciting artists working right now are shortlisted to win the prize based on an outstanding exhibition that has taken place in the previous year. The nominated artists in 2019 are: Lawrence Abu Hamdan, Helen Cammock, Oscar Murillo, and Tai Shani. [Find out more about the artists.](#)

The offer

Autumn 2019 will be an exciting time for young people to visit Margate and explore cutting edge contemporary art. This November, we are pleased to be offering secondary schools across Kent the chance to visit the Turner Prize 2019 exhibition in Margate with subsidised travel, provided by [Taylor Travel Ltd](#). Entry to the exhibition is free, and subsidised travel is available to any secondary school and college in Kent and Medway, for groups of Year 9 upwards, subject to a successful application.

Please note that due to the content of the exhibition, we will only be accepting applications through this scheme from age groups of Year 9 upwards. We recommend talking to the learning team prior to your visit, and pre-visits are welcomed and encouraged.

Turner Contemporary is a charity and is able to provide this opportunity thanks to the support and funding from our generous sponsors and supporters.

Details

- Subsidised travel will be offered on every weekday in November, from 01.11.19 to 29.11.19. Schools can apply for morning or afternoon entry to the gallery (Morning slot 11am – 1pm, afternoon slot 1pm – 3pm).
- Taylor Travel will provide one coach of up to 62 passengers per time slot.
- Schools can apply to book up to 4 coaches, one coach per time slot.
- Secondary schools and colleges based only in Kent and Medway are eligible to apply for the bursary.
- Lunch spaces will not be available at the gallery, but students may eat lunch on the coach.

Criteria

Applications will be subject to the following criteria:

- Your school's commitment to the arts or commitment to improving arts provision
- The financial need for subsidised travel
- How your students would benefit from seeing Turner Prize 2019

How to apply

Applications can be made by completing and returning the form on the next page. Once applications have been assessed, successful schools will receive an offer the week following the deadline.

About Turner Prize 2019

The Turner Prize is named after J.M.W. Turner (1775-1851) who was an innovative and controversial artist in his day, is now seen as one of the greatest British artists, and expressed a wish to establish a prize for young artists. Turner Contemporary is named after the artist for similar reasons; our work is inspired by Turner's innovative and radical approach to art.
