# LOOK

Spend 2 minutes looking at a single artwork.

What was the first thing you noticed?

Did anything new reveal itself, the longer you looked?

How did you look at the artwork?

Did your eyes rest in one place or were they led on a journey?

OR

further away

from the artwork to find the best viewpoint.

# THINK

Before you read the wall text, note down or discuss your initial thoughts.

Now read the wall text.

Were your first thoughts anything like the artist's intention?

# WONDER

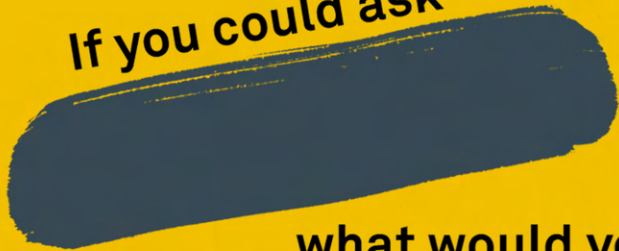
If the artwork could talk, what would it say?
